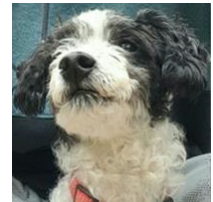

Graf Tree Care moves into New Facility

In January of 2016, we purchased an empty 5,200 square foot building in Batavia, IL. After the design phase and architectural drawings were completed for our custom buildout, the interior construction began in April. Our 900 square foot office was built with a mezzanine overhead for storage. Company Owner Phil Graf decided to use this opportunity to showcase urban wood utilization. Recycled wood planks were used to create our desks, cabinets, shelves, window sills, and a conference room table; all from trees that were removed by our crews and milled right here in Batavia. Our 4,300 square foot shop includes a 66 foot long work bench made from solid Oak, a rolling shop table made from Ash wood, and an indoor wash bay for keeping trucks and equipment clean. Scott Turney was hired as our Fleet and Facility Manager to keep us up and running efficiently in the new building. We moved in on November 1, and have been operating much more efficiently in our new home, complete with our shop dog, Ringo.

If we are not currently fertilizing your trees each spring, please contact us so we can set up a time to evaluate your trees.



Certified Arborist Leslie Delles, our lead data collector, along with Zac and Phil are out in the field collecting data for GIS Tree Inventories, Reforestation Planning, Urban Forestry Management Planning, and Tree Risk Management. Steve Lane, our GIS Coordinator, is using tools such as 3D modeling and canopy cover / canopy volume analysis to improve our urban forest. Steve will continue speaking and educating on a national level, this time at the 55th annual Minnesota Shade Tree Short Course at Bethel University. Jim Semelka has joined our team as a Municipal Consulting Forester. Jim brings over 40 years of experience in urban forest management and is an ISA Certified Arborist Municipal Specialist.
